Scientific research and fields of work

Ecological Economics: From the position of the economy as a subsystem of society and nature the topic is to look for the intelligent integration of the economic system into the social system and into the comprehensive ecological system. What politics by states, governmental and non-governmental organisations, enterprises and society should be chosen to attain sustainable development. Questions of the limitations, political framework conditions and incentive systems (e.g. socio-ecological tax reform) are examined.

Caring Economy: Caring Economy is a research concept which pictures the market economy as a subsystem of the whole economy, the society and the ecosystem. Not only the performances of the market economy but also the performances in the private households (diet, bringing up of children, care of ill and old people), the performances (common goods, collective and public goods) which are provided by the community (state, NGO, neighbourhood) and the production and reproduction of nature are important. It is necessary

to analyse and to point out the significance of the non-market economy for a sustainable development and to uncover the faults of development in the industrialized world.

Analyses to current economy political problems and framework conditions concerning to a future-oriented development of society, economy and nature:

Globalisation and sustainable development; limits of growth and growth criticism; unemployment and the future of work; demographic development in the Federal Republic of Germany and its effects on the development in society, economy and the future of the welfare state; finance problems of the public budgets and the system of the social welfare; future-oriented money systems, (global and local money systems as general partner currencies).
